0516-1398 extendvg

“ 0516-1398 extendvg: The physical volume hdisk1, appears to belong to another volume group. Use the force option to add this physical volume to a volume group.

Solution:

```
extendvg -f rootvg hdisk1
```

File too large

“ ./H11072988.iso: File too large

Solution:

Edit: `/etc/security/limits`

```
root:  
    fsize = -1
```

Re-login then run the command

```
ulimit -a
```

vmount: Operation not permitted

Solution:

```
# check nfs_use_reserved_ports if it is on 0 or 1
nfsd -a

# Change nfs_use_reserved_ports to 1 until nextboot
nfsd -o nfs_use_reserved_ports=1

# Make change to permanent value
nfsd -po nfs_use_reserved_ports=1
```

lppchk: Inconsistent state

““ lppchk: The following filesets need to be installed or corrected to bring the system to a consistent state:

bos.net.nfs.client 7.2.5.201	(usr: APPLIED, root: not installed)
bos.net.nfs.client 7.2.5.203	(usr: APPLIED, root: not installed)

Solution:

```
installp -0r bos.net.nfs.client
```
